Welcome to the *Medical Terminology: An Illustrated Guide, Fifth Edition*, Student Resources CD-ROM! You'll find a variety of exercises and activities to help you remember medical terminology and to reinforce what you've learned in the text, including:

- **Exercises by Chapter** - Unscoored exercises that allow you to choose the types of exercises that best suit your learning style, including:
 - *Multiple choice, fill-in-the-blank, and true/false* questions to support learning.
 - *Figure-labeling* exercises to reinforce your knowledge of both medical terms and basic anatomy through visual diagrams.
 - *Matching games* in which you match combining forms or terms with definitions.
 - *Spelling bee* to help you recognize by sound and correctly spell medical terms.
 - *Case studies* that use actual medical records so you can apply your learning to real-world examples.
- **Review or Test Mode** - Study a single chapter or multiple chapters in a Review or Test environment to test your knowledge; question types are randomized and include multiple choice, fill-in-the-blank, true/false, and spelling bee.
 - *Review Mode* lets you answer questions, receive immediate feedback on your selection, and view the rationales for each answer. Your answers are not recorded.
 - *Test Mode* simulates testing conditions, allowing you to respond to random questions and record your answers. After you complete a Test, you can view the results and then see your responses along with the correct answers and rationales.
- **Pronunciation Drill** - Audio pronunciations organized both A-to-Z and by chapter; select individual terms to hear the pronunciation, or "play all" terms from a chapter sequentially.
- **Dictionary** - Electronic glossary of all key terms from the book organized both A-to-Z and by chapter; definitions provided by *Stedman's Medical Dictionary, 28th edition*.
- **Flash Cards** - Interactive flash cards that can be reviewed electronically by chapter.
